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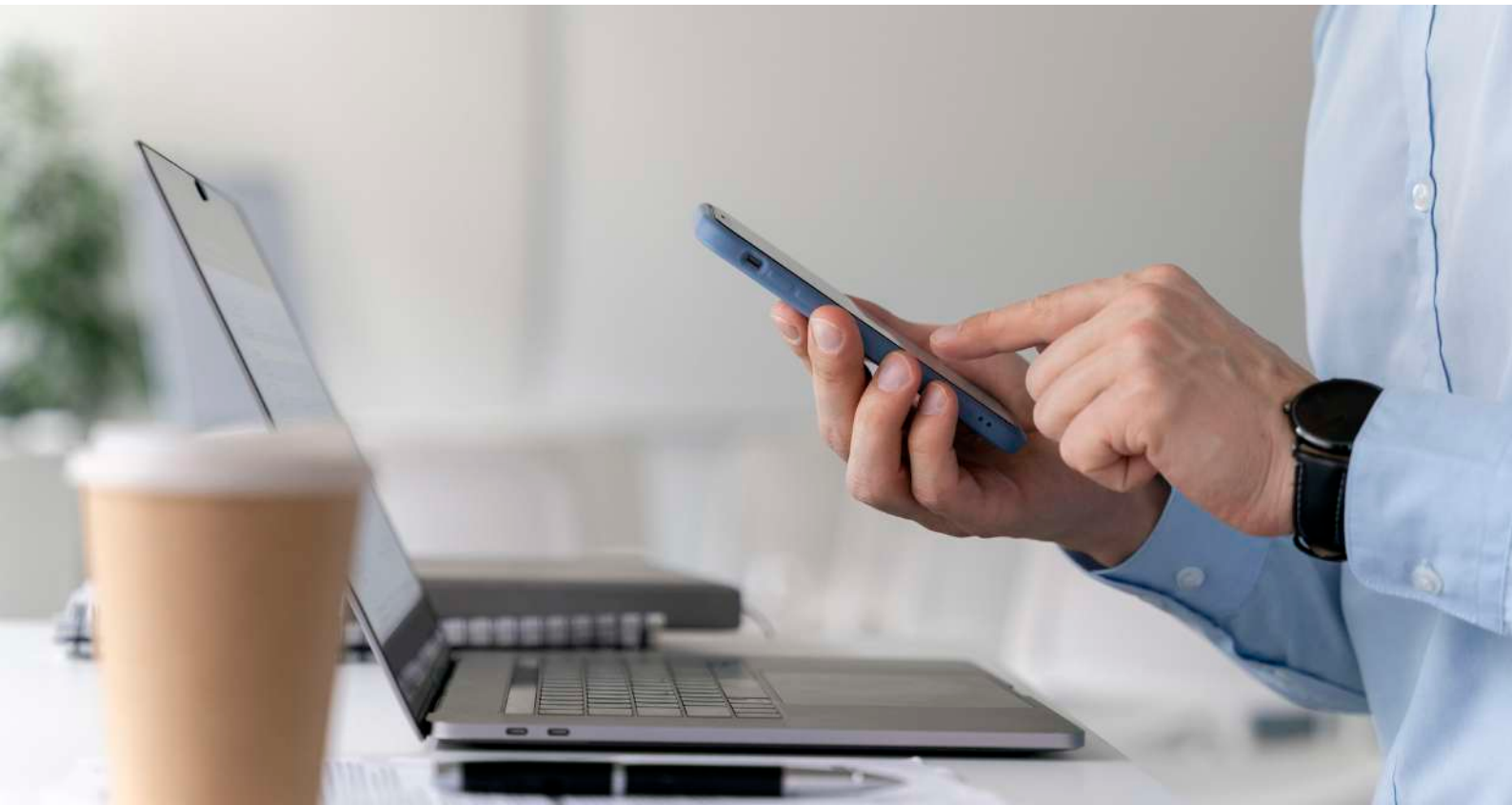

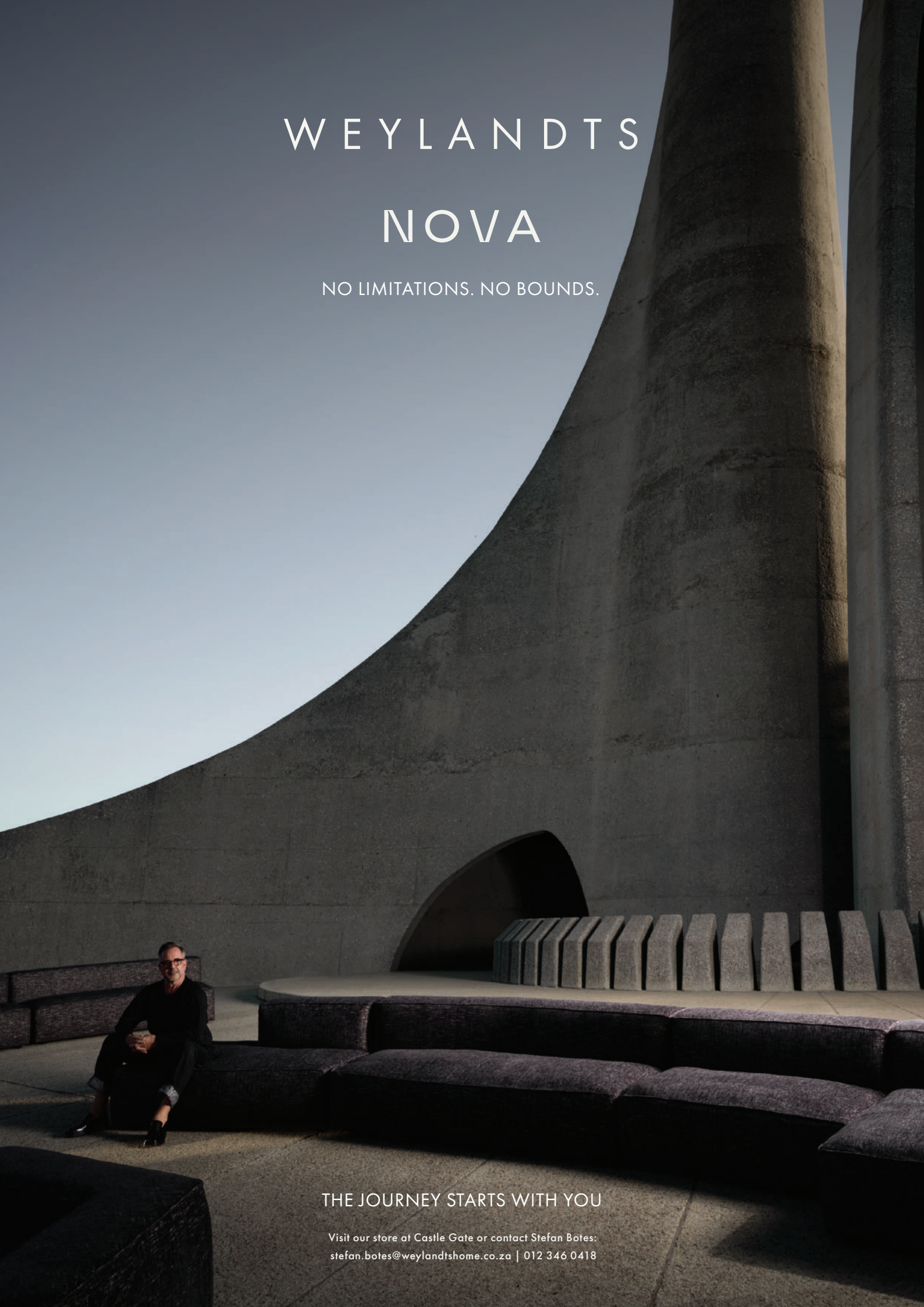

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HERITAGE HILL ESTATE CONDUCT RULES SUMMARY

Compliance

- All residents, tenants, visitors, contractors, and service providers must comply with these rules.
- Owners are responsible for the conduct of their occupants and guests.
- Non-compliance may result in fines or other enforcement action.

Security

- Access is strictly controlled via estate systems.
- Residents must register for biometric/ card access; visitors require codes.
- Security personnel must be respected at all times.
- No tampering with security systems or fences.

Traffic & Roads

- Normal road traffic laws apply.
- Maximum speed: 30 km/h.
- Pedestrians have right of way.
- Licensed drivers and roadworthy vehicles only.
- Reckless, noisy or inconsiderate driving

is prohibited.

- No parking on lawns, sidewalks, or in ways that obstruct traffic.

Common Property

- Facilities (parks, clubhouse, dam, swimming pool, tennis courts) are for resident use only and at own risk.
- No vandalism, littering, loitering, open fires, or misuse of property.
- Dam use: no swimming, fishing, or boating. Children under 12 must be supervised.
- Clubhouse and parks may be hired; facilities must be left clean. Noise to be kept minimal after 20:00.

Maintenance of Erven

- Owners must keep homes, gardens, and sidewalks neat and in good condition.
- Rubble/refuse may not be dumped or stored on erven.
- Refuse bins may only be placed out the night before collection and removed same day.

Pets & Animals

- Maximum: 2 dogs OR 2 cats OR 1 dog & 1 cat, plus up to 5 small pets (e.g., rabbits, guinea pigs).
- All pets must be registered with the HOA, tagged, neutered/spayed, and inoculated.
- Pets must be leashed outside properties.
- Owners must clean up after pets immediately.
- No exotic, farm, or dangerous animals allowed.
- Pets causing nuisance may be removed from the Estate.

Business Activities

- No business may be conducted from a property without HOA approval.
- Approval may be withdrawn if the activity causes nuisance or disrupts estate living.

Noise & Nuisance

- Quiet hours: 22:00 – 06:00 weekdays; 00:00 – 06:00 weekends/ public holidays.
- Generators only during power outages (05:00–22:00) or testing (max 1 hour, 05:00–18:00).
- No fireworks permitted.

9. Estate Agents

- Only HOA-affiliated estate agents may operate in the Estate.
- On-show signs limited to approved boards and must be removed by 17:00 on the show day.

Enforcement & Penalties

- Written warnings, fines, or legal action may be taken for violations.
- Fines range from R500 (minor) to R1000 (major or repeat offences), as per Schedule of Fines.

What follows are just three of the deliciously tantalising recipes Heleen prepared:

A Refreshing Start: Rooibos & Berry Iced Tea

The demonstration began with a glass of chilled rooibos and berry iced tea—Heleen's healthy and refreshing twist on a classic South African favourite. Infused with berries and apples, the drink was a hit. "It's my go-to for hot summer days," Heleen shared. "Beautiful to look at, easy to make, and can be made free of added sugar—it ticks all the boxes."

Soul Food: Roasted Tomato Soup

Next up was a deeply comforting roasted tomato soup, delicately spiced with cumin and served with delicious freshly baked bread. "This is the kind of soup I turn to on a busy weeknight," she explained. "Roasting the tomatoes intensifies their flavour, and cumin adds just the right depth." As the aroma filled the room, guests scribbled notes and snapped photos, eager to try the dish at home.

Fresh & Vibrant: Mexican Bean Salad

For another fresh summer favourite, Heleen served a vibrant Mexican salad, bursting with colour and crunch. Using ingredients like black beans,

sweetcorn, fresh coriander, and a tangy lime dressing, the salad was as nourishing as it was eye-catching. “It’s the perfect braai side,” she noted.

Throughout the demonstration, Heleen shared helpful cooking tips and personal anecdotes, inviting the audience into her world of everyday, real-life cooking. “I want to show people that good food doesn’t have to be complicated,” she said. “With a bit of planning and the right ingredients, anyone can cook with confidence.”

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Early Checks, Brighter Futures

October marks Breast Cancer Awareness Month, a global reminder of the importance of women's health and the power of early detection. While the pink ribbon is a familiar symbol, it represents much more than awareness. It symbolises courage, hope, and the strength of a community that stands together in the fight against breast cancer.

Why Awareness Matters

Breast cancer is one of the most common cancers among women, but the good news is that when it's found early, treatment is far more effective, and the chances of survival are significantly higher. Awareness is the first step, because you can't act on what you don't know. By sharing information,

encouraging screenings, and supporting those affected, we all play a role in saving lives.

Know Your Normal

Every woman's body is unique, which is why "knowing your normal" is so important. Become familiar with how your breasts look and feel. Set aside a few minutes each month—ideally a few days after your menstrual cycle—to check for any changes. Look in the mirror for differences in shape, size, or skin texture. Feel for lumps, unusual thickening, or tenderness. If something feels different and doesn't go away after a cycle, don't wait. Book a check-up with your doctor.

The Power of Screening

Medical experts recommend that women begin routine mammograms at the age of 40. Between the ages of 40 and 54, an annual mammogram is suggested. From

55 onwards, you can choose to continue yearly or switch to every two years. If you have a strong family history of breast cancer, speak to your doctor about starting screenings earlier or adding additional tests like MRI scans. Mammograms may sound intimidating, but they are quick, safe, and could be lifesaving.

Healthy Habits for Prevention

While not all breast cancers are preventable, lifestyle choices do play a role in lowering risk. Staying physically active, maintaining a healthy weight, limiting alcohol intake, and not smoking are all proven ways to support breast health. Breastfeeding, when possible, can also reduce risk. Think of these steps not as restrictions but as part of a balanced lifestyle that nourishes your whole body.

Busting the Myths

Myth: Only women with a family history of breast cancer are at risk.

Fact: Most women diagnosed have no family history.

Myth: A breast lump always means cancer.

Fact: Many lumps are benign, but all should be checked.

Myth: Breast cancer only affects older women.

Fact: While risk increases with age, it can occur in younger women too, and even men.

You're Not Alone

A breast cancer diagnosis can feel overwhelming, but support is out there. Organisations like CANSA, the Breast Health Foundation, and Reach for Recovery offer resources ranging from counselling to survivor support groups.

These networks provide guidance, comfort, and a reminder that no one has to walk this journey alone.

A Call to Action

This October, let's go beyond wearing pink. Book your mammogram, encourage your friends to do the same, and share knowledge that might save a life.

Awareness is powerful, but action is even stronger. By standing together, spreading information, and supporting one another, we can change futures.

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CANINE DISTEMPER IN GAUTENG: WHAT EVERY DOG OWNER NEEDS TO KNOW.

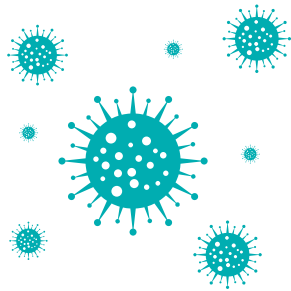
What is Canine Distemper?

Canine distemper (often called “hondesiekte” in Afrikaans) is a highly contagious and potentially deadly viral disease that affects dogs and some wild animals.

It's caused by the Canine Distemper Virus (CDV), a member of the Paramyxoviridae family.

The virus attacks multiple body systems, especially:

- The respiratory tract
- Gastrointestinal tract
- Nervous system



Who is at risk?

All dogs: are susceptible, but puppies and unvaccinated dogs are at higher risk.

Younger puppies: (under 4 months) are particularly vulnerable.



Recent Situation in Gauteng:

Gauteng has experienced confirmed outbreaks of canine distemper.

One such outbreak occurred at the Waltloo branch of the Tshwane SPCA, where unvaccinated or under-vaccinated dogs are particularly at risk.

Veterinary and animal welfare organisations in Gauteng have been urging dog owners to ensure their pets are vaccinated, especially given how rapidly the disease can spread and how serious its effects are.

How Canine Distemper Spreads:

- **MOST IMPORTANT:** airborne exposure (coughing, barking, sneezing) from infected animals.
- Through direct contact (nose or eye discharge, saliva, urine, faeces) or indirect contact (shared food/water bowls, bedding, etc.).
- In some cases, from mother to puppies. Infected dogs may also shed the virus for a prolonged period, even after recovery.
- Once a dog is infected, the virus is shed into the environment in faeces and other bodily secretions.
- Some infected dogs may shed virus particles for several months.

Signs & Symptoms:

Early symptoms often mimic respiratory diseases:

- Fever
- Eye and nose discharge (initially watery, then more severe)
- Coughing, sneezing
- Loss of appetite, lethargy



As the disease advances:

- Vomiting, diarrhoea
- Weakness
- Neurological signs in many cases: twitching, seizures, paralysis, head tilts, etc.

The prognosis becomes poor once the nervous system is affected. Puppies are particularly vulnerable, with mortality rates higher among young, unvaccinated dogs.

Dogs surviving the acute phase may have [hyperkeratosis](#) of the footpads and epithelium of the nasal planum, as well as [enamel hypoplasia](#) in incompletely erupted teeth.

Diagnosis & Treatment:

Diagnosis is generally clinical (based on signs and history), supported by laboratory tests in some cases (tissue samples, PCR, etc.).

Treatment is supportive. There is no cure that kills the virus once infection is established.

In severe cases, euthanasia is considered to prevent undue suffering.

Prevention & Vaccine Strategy:

Prevention is key. The vaccine is currently the only reliable defence against canine distemper. Key points:

- All “5-in-1” vaccines cover the Canine Distemper Virus.
- Puppies need a full course of vaccinations, and adult dogs need boosters.
- Keeping vaccinations up to date is essential, especially in areas where outbreaks have been confirmed (e.g. Gauteng).
- Good hygiene: disinfecting bowls, bedding, and areas where infected animals have been; quarantining sick animals.



What Dog Owners in Gauteng Should Do Now:

1. Check your dog's vaccination history — if your dog hasn't had a booster in the past year, schedule one ASAP.
2. Watch for early symptoms — especially eye/nose discharge, fever, reduced appetite. Early detection can help with supportive care.
3. Isolate any dog showing symptoms from other dogs, and get veterinary help right away.
4. Maintain hygiene practices — disinfection of bowls, bedding, spaces after exposure to sick animals; wash hands; avoid sharing equipment between dogs.
5. Support community awareness — share information with neighbours, pet groups; encourage vaccination drives locally.



Conclusion

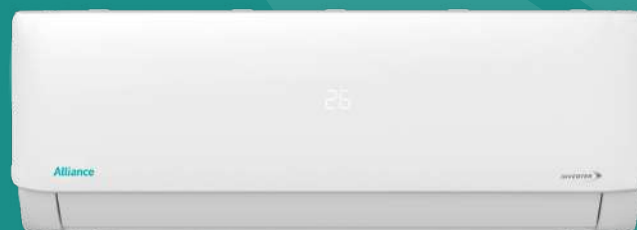
Canine distemper remains a serious concern in Gauteng. While not all outbreaks are publicised, evidence confirms that the disease is present, spreading, and deadly, especially in unvaccinated dogs. But unlike many viral diseases, distemper is preventable — through robust vaccination, responsible pet ownership, and timely response when suspected cases emerge. For the sake of individual pets and the broader animal population, preventative action is not just wise, it's essential.

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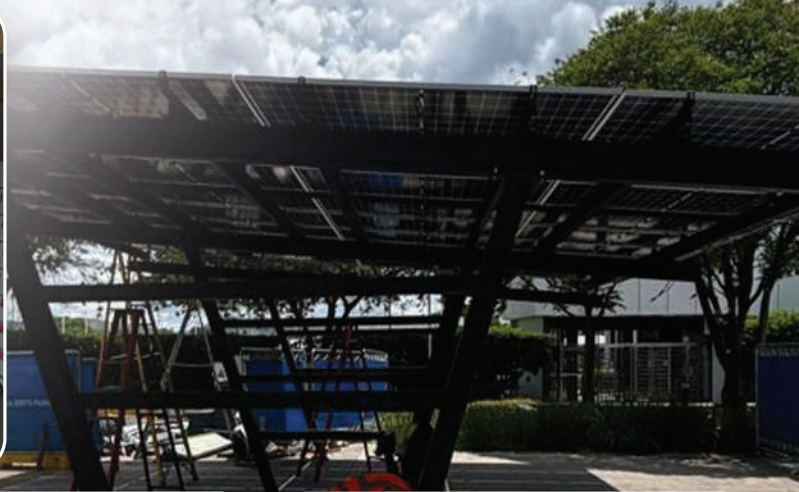
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plant SPA DAY
